

# BABY'S 1ST YEAR

## 3-6 MONTHS

### Visual

- A baby's range of vision continues to grow as eye tracking skills develop
- Around 4 months old, their eyes can move & see objects in unison for the first time
- Babies begin to recognize familiar faces in their lives around 5 months

### Motor

- Infants start to utilize two hands together around 4 months as their motor skills develop - like gripping their hands together across their chest
- Improved hand-eye coordination allows babies to pass objects from one hand to another
- Babies may begin to suck on their fingers more around 3 months

### Gross Motor

- Babies can keep their necks steadier by 4 months, & they can take in more of their surroundings through improved vision & the sense of touch
- Reaching for their toes becomes a favorite activity
- Rolling over, turning, and sprawling out while sleeping becomes more common

### Auditory

- Around 4 months infants are able to recognize different intonations of high & low pitch sounds of speech

### Oral

- Babies learn about objects by moving them from their hands to their mouth
- Teething begins around 5 months, & babies seek comfort for their sore & itchy gums
